Dear Mr. Lewandowski:

On November 8th, voters will elect the 45th President of the United States. Millions of those voters will be members, allies and supporters of the lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) community. We noted Mr. Trump's statement in response to the Orlando massacre that he is a "real friend" of the LGBT community.

Equality Forum is a nonprofit and 501(c)(3) national and international LGBT civil rights organization with an educational focus. Part of the mission is to inform the public on the position of candidates for public office on LGBT civil rights issues. Equality Forum neither endorses a party nor a candidate for public elective office.

In 28 states, LGBT employees lack workplace protections. Likewise, there is no workplace protection based on sexual orientation or gender identity pursuant to the federal Employment Nondiscrimination Act (ENDA).

The Equality Act, a bipartisan bill was introduced last year in the Senate and United State House of Representatives. The legislation would amend the Civil Rights Act of 1964 to include protections that ban discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation and gender identity in the areas of employment, housing, public accommodations, public education, federal funding, credit and the judicial system.

Former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton has publicly pledged her support of the Equality Act.

Does Mr. Trump support or oppose the passage of the Equality Act?

We respectfully request Mr. Trump's position by Monday, June 27, 2016.
